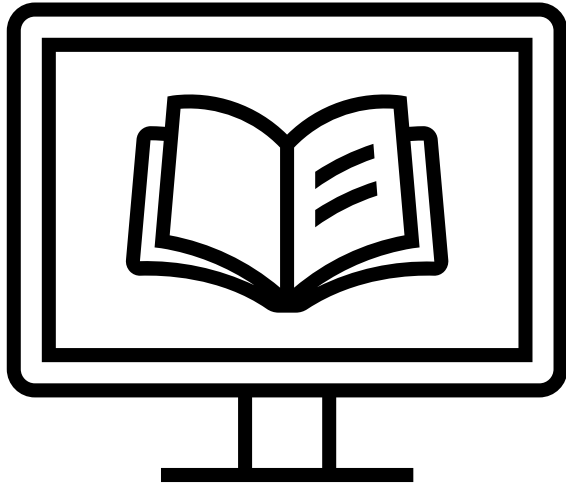

Canvas Script & Canvas API

Canvas Script

A Python script that uses the Canvas API to automate tasks, saving time by doing batch work instead of manual effort.

Canvas API

A set of tools that let you interact with Canvas programmatically. It allows you to get, update, and manage course data like assignments, grades, users, and content using code instead of doing it manually.
